### TRAVEL TEAMS

For those athletes that wish to compete in national invitational volleyball tournaments, CCJ will offer **National Teams** consisting of competitive teams at the 18-and-under, 16-and-under, and 14-and-under age levels as determined by USA Volleyball Age Policy. In 2012, our teams will compete in the **Cactus Classic Invitational, Las Vegas Invitational, Colorado Crossroads Junior Qualifier, Far Western Junior Qualifier**, and either the **USAV Junior Nationals** (if qualified) or the **Volleyball Festival**.

### REGION TEAMS

CCJ will offer Region Teams at every age level that will compete in the Arizona Region's competition schedule, January to May. These teams offer excellent off-season training opportunities for all players looking to improve for their high school teams. The tuition is affordable due to the lack of travel costs, however each team gets the unique opportunity to compete in the **Cactus Classic Invitational**, a national invitational tournament hosted by CCJ held in January at the Tucson Convention Center.

### YOUTH VOLLEYBALL

CCJ offers excellent developmental programs for younger players in partnership with YMCA.

**8-AND-UNDER, 10-AND-UNDER PROGRAMS:** Training sessions with limited competition will be introduced this season for aspiring young players that want to have fun while receiving positive reinforcement from some of the area's top high school and club coaches.

**12-AND-UNDER PROGRAMS:** CCJ will offer a competitive 12-and-under program that will compete in the Cactus Classic Invitational, the Arizona Region; as well as a program that offers training sessions with limited competition for aspiring young players that want to have fun while receiving positive reinforcement from some of the area's top high school and club coaches.

**14-AND-UNDER PROGRAMS:** CCJ will offer competitive 14-and-under teams that will compete in the Arizona Region and offer an excellent off-season training opportunity for all players looking to improve for their middle school or freshman teams.

## Practice Venues and Schedule

Beginning January 2012, all CCJ teams will train at two to three times a week, including Saturday and/or Sunday practices. Final practice times and venues will be announced once teams have been formed. Ironwood Ridge High School is the main training venue, along with Amphitheater High School and other local high school venues.
