


Report to the Volunteer Coordinator by 5:00 PM and we will begin as soon as event finishes.

SET-UP OVERVIEW

Volunteers will be organized into groups (6 people can set-up one court in 40 minutes)

Each court will have two crates staged near the court (one red; one blue)

Carpet underlayment (4 rolls per court)

Laying the Court Tiles (IMPORTANT)

13 tiles create the baseline

Work off the baseline, keeping all tiles straight

No more than two rows ahead (keep the court plum)




























TEAR DOWN PROCEDURES

Volunteers will be organized into groups of 6 people per court

Additional Groups for Equipment and Dock Loading

DO NOT START UNTIL COURT NUMBER IS REMOVED!

The only person that can remove a number is the Lead Official

The Four Commandants of Tear-Down:

One color per crate (both sides) and only two crates per court

The loops will always be to the back and to the right

Tiles must be pushed ALL THE WAY IN

Each side will have 81 sheets of tile
